

# Plural Nouns Party

A Plural Noun is more than one person, place or thing. We usually add an s to show that a noun is plural. If a noun ends in x, ch, sh, or s, we add an es to the word.

Examples: cat = cats      glass = glasses      dish = dishes

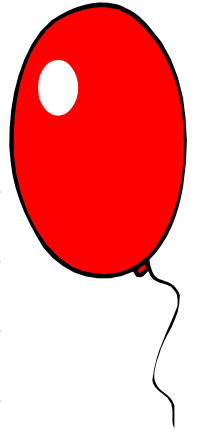
